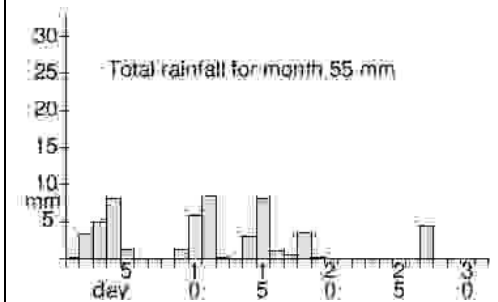
Country roads

Top tip for Leyburn

It will be necessary to register before your next visit to local household waste recycling centres, including the waste centre up in Leyburn. You need to register giving name, address, email/phone and vehicle details. This is to ensure the facility is only used by residents. Registration lasts for 3 years.
